<u>Existing law</u> prohibits persons of the same sex contracting marriage with each other.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further provides that a purported marriage between persons of the same sex contracted in another state shall be governed by the provisions of Title II of Book IV of the Civil Code.

<u>New law</u> provides that a purported marriage between persons of the same sex violates strong public policy of the state of Louisiana and such a marriage contracted in another state shall not be recognized in this state for any purpose.
