

New law creates the Sons of Confederate Veterans prestige license plate. Further provides that such plates may be issued to any member of the camp of Sons of Confederate Veterans. Restricts the issuance of such plates to passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, and vans. Requires a minimum of 100 applicants for such plate. Further provides for the design and color of the plate.

New law requires the submission of a certificate of good standing of the Sons of Confederate Veterans, signed and notarized by the camp commander.

New law provides for a \$28.50 fee assessed every two years in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration license fee. Provides that \$3.50 shall be retained by the department for handling purposes, and the remainder shall be forwarded to the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to be used for providing Louisiana history textbooks to elementary and secondary schools.

New law requires the promulgation of rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.
