MTR VEHICLE/WEIGHT REGS: Provides for unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:387.11(C), relative to semiannual critical off-road equipment permit; to 3 provide for a permit to be issued to authorize unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle; 4 and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 32:387.11(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §387.11. Semiannual critical off-road equipment permit; authorization 8 9 C. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in addition to the 10 permit issued pursuant to this Section, the secretary shall issue concurrent permits 11 for unladen lift equipment to tow a double axle vehicle not to exceed ten thousand 12 pounds. This permit shall be valid for seventy-two or one hundred forty-four hours 13 at a charge not to exceed fifty dollars. As used in this Subsection, "unladen lift 14 equipment" shall mean a motor vehicle designed for use as lift equipment used solely 15 to raise, shift, or lower heavy weights by means of a projecting, swinging mast, with 16 an engine for power on a chassis permanently constructed or assembled for such 17 purpose.

Abstract: Provides for unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle.

Proposed law provides for a permit to be issued for unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "unladen lift equipment" as a motor vehicle designed for use as lift equipment used solely to raise, shift, or lower heavy weights by means of a projecting, swinging mast, with an engine for power on a chassis permanently constructed or assembled for such purpose.
