
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 1 by Representative Fannin

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, between lines 26 and 27, insert the following:

3 "D. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each agency which has contracted
4 with outside legal counsel for representation in an action against another agency, shall
5 submit a detailed report of all litigation costs incurred and payable to the outside counsel to
6 the commissioner of administration, the legislative committee charged with oversight of that
7 agency, and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. The report shall be submitted
8 on a quarterly basis, each January, April, July, and October, and shall include all litigation
9 costs paid and payable during the prior quarter. For purposes of this Subsection, the term
10 "litigation expenses" shall mean court costs and attorney fees of the agency and of the other
11 party if the agency was required to pay such costs and fees. The commissioner of
12 administration shall not authorize any payments for any such contract until such report for
13 the prior quarter has been submitted."

34 \$5,168,099, Fees and Self-Generated Revenues by \$3,550,731; State General Fund by
35 Statutory Dedications by \$7,080,543; and Federal by \$4,816,949.

36 (2) The commissioner of administration shall have the authority to take actions
37 necessary to ensure that no appropriation contained in this Act or the Ancillary
38 Appropriation Act shall be used to fund a merit pay increase for any unclassified
39 employee. The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to
40 make necessary reductions in this Act and the Ancillary Appropriation Act for the
41 2009-2010 Fiscal Year by \$33,795 for unclassified state employees merit increases, by

1 reducing State General Fund by Interagency Transfer by \$31,510; Fees and
2 Self-Generated Revenues by \$11; and Federal by \$2,274."
