
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE HOUSE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Peterson in the Committee of the Whole House to Engrossed House Bill No. 1 by Representative Fannin

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 244, delete lines 1 through 6 in their entirety

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 264, delete line 9 in its entirety and insert the following:

5 "development account programming and other educational
6 initiatives \$ 275,000"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 271, between lines 18 and 19 insert the following:

9 "Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct)
10 to the West Feliciana Parish Police Jury for
11 student employment and Recreation Initiatives \$ 50,000

12 Provided, however, that such monies shall only be expended in the event the Insure
13 Louisiana Incentive Program Fund is abolished and any monies remaining in the fund are
14 transferred for deposit and credit to the state general fund. In the event that monies
15 deposited into the state general fund from the Insure Louisiana Incentive Program Fund are
16 insufficient to fully fund expenditures subject to the abolition of the fund, each appropriation
17 shall receive the same pro rata share of the monies available which its allocation represents
18 to the total.

19 Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct)
20 to the City of St. Gabriel for economic
21 development \$ 25,000

22 Provided, however, that such monies shall only be expended in the event the Insure
23 Louisiana Incentive Program Fund is abolished and any monies remaining in the fund are
24 transferred for deposit and credit to the state general fund. In the event that monies
25 deposited into the state general fund from the Insure Louisiana Incentive Program Fund are
26 insufficient to fully fund expenditures subject to the abolition of the fund, each appropriation
27 shall receive the same pro rata share of the monies available which its allocation represents
28 to the total.

29 Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct)
30 to the City of Richwood \$ 50,000

31 Provided, however, that such monies shall only be expended in the event the Insure
32 Louisiana Incentive Program Fund is abolished and any monies remaining in the fund are
33 transferred for deposit and credit to the state general fund. In the event that monies
34 deposited into the state general fund from the Insure Louisiana Incentive Program Fund are
35 insufficient to fully fund expenditures subject to the abolition of the fund, each appropriation
36 shall receive the same pro rata share of the monies available which its allocation represents
37 to the total."
