HOLIDAYS. Makes Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday a legal holiday for public schools.

Jones (SB 246) DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides that the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Great American Day and Presidents' Day may be called as a holiday for public schools. <u>Present law</u> further provides that should local school boards exercise this option on a regularly scheduled school day, they may do so, with or

without the necessity of adjourning school for all or any portion of the day.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains local school board option as provided in <u>present law</u>, and provides that the third Monday in January, the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., shall be a legal holiday for all public schools, deleting the designation of that same day as Great American Day and Presidents' Day.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and</u> <u>Governmental Affairs to the original bill.</u>

- 1. Deletes all proposed change except to designate the third Monday in January, the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., as a legal holiday for public schools.
- 2. Deletes current law also designating the third Monday in January as Great American Day and Presidents' Day.
