Creates the Crescent City Connection Commission

The proposed legislation creates the Crescent City Connection Commission. The object and purpose of this commission is to advise and recommend to the secretary of DOTD on issues relative to the operations and management of the Crescent City Connection Division. The commission shall be composed of members chosen from nominations of the members of the House of Representatives and the Senate (Senate Districts 1,3,7 and 8 plus House Districts 83,84,85,86,87,93,102,104, and 105). The governor shall appoint one member at large. The secretary of DOTD or his designee shall serve as chairman of the commission. The commission shall meet at least once every other month, and on the call of the chairman, at its offices in Algiers, Louisiana, and shall report its business and status to the Joint Legislative Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works, and to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget at least once a year. The legislation repeals the current law providing for the Crescent City Connection Oversight Authority.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The proposed legislation does not include provisions for payment of per diem, travel or any related expenses incurred in performing the duties of commission members.

The proposed legislation repeals statutory authority for the Crescent City Connection Oversight Authority (CCCOA), which is a thirteen member agency whose purpose is to establish priorities of projects from remaining funds after all operation and maintenance expenses of the bridge and ferries under the authority of the Crescent City Connection Division of DOTD have been paid. DOTD indicates that no funds have been expended on the CCCOA in the current fiscal year.


