(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

MTR VEHICLE/WEIGHT REGS: Provides for unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes, if there are no objections raised by the federal government, noncritical off-road equipment that has been issued a valid annual noncritical off-road equipment permit to tow a two-axle vehicle provided the towed vehicle does not exceed 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight and the combination of the off-road equipment and the towed vehicle does not exceed an overall length of 65 feet. Further authorizes counterweights to be carried on the off-road equipment if carried in functional position.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the original bill.</u>

- 1. Changes section of law amended from R.S. 32:387.11 to 387.12.
- 2. Provides that a permit may be issued for noncritical off-road equipment to tow a vehicle if the federal government does not object.
- 3. Provides that a permit may be issued if the noncritical off-road equipment and combination of the noncritical off-road equipment and towed vehicle do not exceed certain lengths.
- 4. Provides requirements for noncritical off-road equipment towing a vehicle and carrying counterweights.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the reengrossed bill.

- 1. Removes the option for a concurrent permit to be issued to allow off-road vehicle to tow a two-axle vehicle.
- 2. Removes the prohibition that non-critical off-road equipment does not exceed forty-five feet in length.
- 3. Removes fee and time restraint.
