TRANSPORTATION: Provides relative to the Parish Transportation Fund

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> requires parishes to adopt a system of road administration which requires approval of the governing authority for any expenditures made out of the Parish Transportation Fund. Prohibits members of the governing authority from expending any funds in his ward or district without the approval of the parish governing authority. Further requires each parish to adopt a parish wide system of administration inclusive of parish roads within municipalities which includes the development of a capital improvement program on a selective basis, centralized purchasing of equipment and supplies, centralized accounting, and selective maintenance and construction.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires parishes to adopt a parish wide system of road administration in order to receive Parish Transportation Fund monies, regardless of the source of funds.
