## HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 352 by Representative Mickey Guillory

MTR VEHICLE/WEIGHT REGS: Provides for unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Deletes requirement that certain noncritical off-road equipment be issued a concurrent permit to tow a vehicle. Allows for option without obtaining concurrent permit.
- 2. Removes the prohibition that non-critical off-road equipment does not exceed forty-five feet in length.
- 3. Removes fee and time restraint.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes, if there are no objections raised by the federal government, noncritical off-road equipment that has been issued a valid annual noncritical off-road equipment permit to tow a two-axle vehicle provided the towed vehicle does not exceed 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight and the combination of the off-road equipment and the towed vehicle does not exceed an overall length of 65 feet. Further authorizes counterweights to be carried on the off-road equipment if carried in functional position.
