

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 352 by Representative Mickey Guillory

MTR VEHICLE/WEIGHT REGS: Provides for unladen lift equipment to tow a vehicle

Synopsis of Senate Amendments	
1.	Deletes requirement that certain noncritical off-road equipment be issued a concurrent permit to tow a vehicle. Allows for option without obtaining concurrent permit.
2.	Removes the prohibition that non-critical off-road equipment does not exceed forty-five feet in length.
3.	Removes fee and time restraint.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law authorizes, if there are no objections raised by the federal government, noncritical off-road equipment that has been issued a valid annual noncritical off-road equipment permit to tow a two-axle vehicle provided the towed vehicle does not exceed 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight and the combination of the off-road equipment and the towed vehicle does not exceed an overall length of 65 feet. Further authorizes counterweights to be carried on the off-road equipment if carried in functional position.
