

Prior law provided that operating expenses, operating revenues, and number of passengers are defined by the Code of Federal Regulations.

New law provides for the definitions of operating expenses, operating revenue or income, and number of passengers.

New law exempts transit systems with nine or fewer bus waivers from the National Transit Database reporting requirements. Requires such transit systems to report data on the number of passengers, operating expenses, and operating revenue or income in accordance with the requirements of the current National Transit Database Reporting Manual. Further requires the data to be reported by these transit systems to the Dept. of Transportation and Development.

Effective July 1, 2009.
