Stiaes HB No. 863

**Abstract:** Prohibits operators of commercial motor vehicles from using hand-held wireless communication devices and provides for penalties.

<u>Present law</u> provides that all operators of motor vehicles are prohibited from texting while driving and shall be enforced only as a secondary action when the officer detains a driver for another alleged violation.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but states that <u>present law</u> shall not apply to operators of commercial motor vehicles.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that operators of commercial motor vehicles shall not text or communicate using a hand-held wireless telecommunication device and that the violation shall be enforced as a primary offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for definitions of "hand-held wireless telecommunications device" and "hands-free wireless telecommunications device".

Proposed law provides for penalties.
