

New law requires DPS&C to suspend the driver's license of drivers who prematurely disable an ignition interlock device installed as a condition of reinstated driving privileges.

New law provides that the suspension shall last until the driver provides proof that the ignition interlock has been reinstalled and applicable reinstatement fees have been paid.

New law provides that upon reinstatement of driving privileges following suspension pursuant to new law, the driver will receive credit only for the time period when the ignition interlock device was installed and functioning.

Effective August 15, 2010.
