The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Michelle Ducharme.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides for legislative intent regarding the state's interest to allow residents of Louisiana to purchase or obtain rifles and shotguns or ammunition in states contiguous to Louisiana.

Present law provides for definitions.

<u>Present law</u> provides that it shall be lawful for any person residing in Louisiana to purchase or otherwise obtain a rifle or shotgun or ammunition in any state which is contiguous to Louisiana and to receive or transport such rifle or shotgun or ammunition into this state.

<u>Present law</u> further lawfully permits any person residing in a contiguous state to purchase shotguns, rifles, or ammunition in Louisiana and to receive or transport such rifles, shotguns, or ammunition in Louisiana.

Present law provides for applicability of present law.

Proposed law repeals the provisions of present law.

Effective August 15, 2011.
