Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY: Exempts sex offenders from provision that provides, without charge, state identification cards to persons of certain age

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1321(H), relative to sex offenders; to prohibit certain sex
3 offenders from obtaining a special identification card without charge; and to provide
4 for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 40:1321(H) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §1321. Special identification cards; issuance; fees; expiration and renewal;
8 exceptions; promulgation of rules; promotion of use; persons less than
9 twenty-one years of age; the Protect and Save our Children Program;
10 Selective Service Registration

11 * * *

12 H. Persons who are residents of this state and who are sixty years of age or
13 older may obtain a special identification card without charge. This provision shall
14 not apply to the special identification card required to be obtained by a sex offender
15 pursuant to Subsection J of this Section. Special identification cards issued under the
16 provisions of this Subsection shall not be subject to the expiration provisions or the
17 renewal requirements of this Section.

Abstract: Prevents certain sex offenders from obtaining a special identification card without charge.

Present law provides an exception to residents of this state and who are sixty years of age or older to obtain a special identification card without charge. Further exempts the residents from expiration and renewal provisions.

Proposed law retains present law, but exempts sex offenders from obtaining a special identification card without charge.
