The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Michelle Ducharme.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> defines "net proceeds" as gross lottery revenues minus amounts paid or estimated to be paid as prizes and expenses of operation of the lottery.

<u>Proposed law</u> excludes donations collected by the Louisiana Lottery Corporation for certain special instant games from the definition of "net proceeds".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the board to offer a special instant game entitled "Ticket for the Cure".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the president shall determine the cost for each ticket and mandates that no ticket shall be issued unless a donation of two dollars is collected with the purchase of the ticket.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the corporation shall collect the donation for each ticket sold from each retailer and forward the donation to the American Cancer Society, Mid-South Division.
