TAX EXEMPTIONS. Provides for a state sales and use tax exemption for certain transactions related to certain inhibitors and certain complex biologics. (7/1/11)

7	Section 1. R.S. 47:305.66 and 337.9(D)(30) are hereby enacted to read as follows:				
8	§305.66. Exemption; certain medical inhibitors and certain complex biologics				
9	A The sales and use tax imposed by the state of Louisiana or any of				
10	its political subdivisions shall not apply to the sale of the following medications				
11	in this state:				
12	(1) Vaso-endothelial growth factor, known as VEGF inhibitors.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 47:337.10(K)(1)) only exempts the following from the sales and use tax of any political subdivision in any parish with a population between 230,000 and 300,000 according to the most recent decennial census:

- (1) Vaso-endothelial growth factor, known as VEGF inhibitors, including but not limited to Visudyne and Macugen.
- (2) Complex biologics such as monoclonal antibodies, including but not limited to Infliximab.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u> and grants a statewide exemption from the state sales and use tax and the state and use tax of any political subdivision in this state:

- (1) Vaso-endothelial growth factor, known as VEGF inhibitors, including but not limited to Visudyne and Macugen.
- (2) Complex biologics such as monoclonal antibodies, including but not limited to Infliximab.

Effective July 1, 2011.
