Purpose of Bill: This measure requires all non-municipal Chiefs of Police appointed or elected on or after January 1, 2012 to attend training courses and continuing education classes administered by the Law Enforcement Executive Management Institute.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

State General Fund expenditures are anticipated to increase as a result of this measure.

According to an official with the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement, an estimated 41 additional police chiefs will be required to attend training. This estimate includes 34 campus police chiefs, 3 harbor police chiefs, 3 police chiefs of Indian tribes, and the chief superintendent of State Police.

The estimated cost to train these chiefs for the first year is approximately \$50,000. Costs of training may vary since the number of non-municipal chiefs of police impacted by this bill has not been officially determined.

The official also stated that future continuing education training will be required biannually at an undetermined cost.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
