TRUSTS. Requests Louisiana State Law Institute to study authorizing creation of testamentary and inter vivos trusts to provide for the care of an animal.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Louisiana State Law Institute to study revising state law to authorize
3	the creation of testamentary and inter vivos trusts to provide for the care of an
4	animal.
5	WHEREAS, as of 2011, over forty states have enacted legislation authorizing under
6	trust and estate laws the creation of a trust to provide for the care of an animal; and
7	WHEREAS, such legislation is commonly referred to as "pet trust" or "animal trust"
8	legislation; and
9	WHEREAS, states that have enacted such legislation include Texas, Arkansas,
10	Alabama, Florida, and Georgia; and
11	WHEREAS, Louisiana is one of the few remaining states that have not enacted such
12	legislation; and
13	WHEREAS, the Uniform Probate Code and the Uniform Trust Code, promulgated
14	by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, include provisions
15	for the establishment of "pet trusts".
16	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
17	does hereby urge and request the Louisiana State Law Institute to study revising state law
18	to authorize creation of testamentary and inter vivos trusts to provide for the care of an
