Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties 10 C. 11 12 13 (2) 14 15 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (6) of this Subsection to the 16 contrary, any opossums, raccoons, nutria, otters, muskrat, mink, or beaver that are 17 found destroying crawfish in a private pond primarily used for the purpose of 18 commercially cultivating crawfish or destroying the structure of such pond may be 19 taken as provided by law by the crawfish farmer or landowner with either a .22 20 caliber rimfire rifle no larger than a .22 caliber or a shotgun no larger than a 12-

gauge using nontoxic shot no larger than BB-sized by the crawfish farmer or

Abstract: Authorizes the use of 12-gauge or smaller shotguns for taking nuisance animals destroying crawfish ponds.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a crawfish farmer or landowner to take nuisance animals (opossums, raccoons, nutria, or beaver) that are destroying crawfish ponds with a .22 caliber rimfire rifle. <u>Proposed law</u> would add otter, muskrat, and mink to the list of nuisance animals covered by these provisions and also authorize the use of a .17 caliber rimfire rifle or a 12-gauge or smaller shotgun using nontoxic shot no larger than BB-sized.
