Hardy HB No. 188

**Abstract:** Makes housing authority affiliates subject to the Public Records Law.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 40:384) defines an "affiliate" of a housing authority as any corporation, entity, partnership, venture, syndicate, or arrangement in which a local housing authority has an ownership or governance interest of less than a majority.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 40:487) provides that affiliates of housing authorities are not subject to the laws of the state applicable to public agencies and their governing bodies by virtue of their affiliation with a local housing authority. <u>Proposed law retains present law except that proposed law provides for the applicability of the Public Records Law to such housing authority affiliates.</u>

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 44:1) provides a definition of the term "public body" as it is used in the Public Records Law. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds affiliates of housing authorities to such definition.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall not require the disclosure of documents or records of persons who hold an ownership interest in, or authority over, an affiliate of a housing authority. Further provides that such protection shall not prevent the disclosure of the identity of persons holding an ownership interest in an affiliate.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs</u> to the original bill.

- 1. Deletes language relative to employees of affiliates being considered public employees for the purposes of the Public Records Law.
- 2. Adds provision regarding individuals and entities having an ownership interest in, or authority over, an affiliate.
