Nowlin HB No. 224

Abstract: Increases court costs collected in criminal cases in the 10th JDC <u>from</u> \$10 to \$15 in traffic offense cases and <u>from</u> \$10 to \$25 in all other criminal cases.

<u>Present law</u> provides, in part, that in addition to all other fees or costs, the clerk of court of the 10th JDC shall collect from every person filing any type of civil suit or proceeding, a sum to be determined by the judges which shall not exceed \$15, and that there shall be collected as costs against every defendant who is convicted after trial or after plea of guilty or who forfeits his bond, a sum which shall not exceed \$10 and which shall be in addition to all other fines, costs, or forfeitures lawfully imposed.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the amount collected as costs against every defendant who is convicted after trial or after plea of guilty or who forfeits his bond in the 10th JDC <u>from</u> \$10 to \$15 in traffic offense cases and <u>from</u> \$10 to \$25 in all other criminal cases.

House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill.

1. Added a maximum of \$15 in court costs in traffic offense cases and increased the maximum from \$20 to \$25 in court costs in all other criminal cases in the 10th JDC.
