Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana. AGRICULTURE: Merges certain funds within the Department of Agriculture and Forestry

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 3:1407, 1421(1)(b), (2)(a) and (b), and (3), 1430.13(A) and (D),
3	1655(C)(3) and (5)(a), 2311(B) and (D)(1), 3210(C)(1), and 3806(G)(2) and (4)(a),
4	relative to certain funds within the Department of Agriculture and Forestry; to
5	provide for the merger of the Feed Fund and the Fertilizer Fund; to provide for the
6	merger of the Crop Pests and Diseases Fund, the Apiary Fund, and the Horticulture
7	Fund; to provide for the Pesticide Fund; to provide for the disposition of monies; and
8	to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 3:1407, 1421(1)(b), (2)(a) and (b), and (3), 1430.13(A) and (D),
11	1655(C)(3) and (5)(a), 2311(B) and (D)(1), 3210(C)(1), and 3806(G)(2) and (4)(a) are
12	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
13	§1407. Disposition of funds
14	A.(1) All fees, assessments, penalties, and all other funds received by the
15	commission under the provisions of this Part Chapter, subject to the exceptions
16	contained in Article VII, Section 9 of the Constitution of Louisiana, shall be
17	deposited immediately upon receipt into the state treasury and shall be credited to the
18	Bond Security and Redemption Fund.
19	(2) Out of the funds remaining in the Bond Security and Redemption Fund
20	after a sufficient amount is allocated from that fund to pay all obligations secured by

1	the full faith and credit of the state which become due and payable within any fiscal
2	year, the treasurer, prior to placing the remaining funds in the state general fund,
3	shall pay an amount equal to the total amount of funds paid into the state treasury by
4	the commission under the provisions of this Part Chapter into a special fund which
5	is hereby created in the state treasury and designated as the "Feed Fund" "Feed and
6	Fertilizer Fund".
7	(3) All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of each
8	fiscal year shall remain in the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the
9	treasurer in the same manner as monies in the state general fund. All interest earned
10	on monies from the fund invested by the state treasurer shall be deposited in the
11	fund.
12	B. Subject to appropriation, the monies in the Feed Fund Feed and Fertilizer
13	Fund shall be used for the following purposes:
14	(1) To provide for the expenses of the programs established by this Part
15	Chapter and the expenses of the office of agricultural and environmental sciences,
16	as determined by the commissioner.
17	(2) To renovate, maintain, and equip a building on the Baton Rouge campus
18	of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College to
19	provide administrative offices and analytical laboratories to be used in connection
20	with the programs established by this Part Chapter.
21	(3) To build, equip, and maintain a building to house the offices of the
22	Department of Agriculture and Forestry.
23	(4) To fund any and all costs related to the fulfillment of the powers,
24	responsibilities, and purposes of this Part Chapter.
25	C. The Department of Agriculture and Forestry or the Louisiana Agricultural
26	Finance Authority on behalf of the Department of Agriculture and Forestry may fund
27	the anticipated funds appropriated from the Feed Fund Feed and Fertilizer Fund into
28	revenue bonds for the purpose of renovating a building on the Baton Rouge campus
29	of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College to

1	provide administrative offices and analytical laboratories to be used in connection
2	with the programs established by this Part Chapter and for the purpose of acquiring,
3	constructing, renovating, and equipping buildings and related facilities for use by the
4	Department of Agriculture and Forestry in connection with promoting and assisting
5	agriculture and forestry in this state. The Department of Agriculture and Forestry
6	may pledge those funds to secure the repayment of revenue bonds or to secure a
7	lease or purchase agreement entered into in connection with the issuance of revenue
8	bonds for those purposes.

10	§1421. Disposition of funds
11	All fees, penalties, except for the deficiency assessments paid to a purchaser-
12	user of fertilizer, as provided for in R.S. 3:1415, and other funds received under the
13	provisions of this Subpart shall be received by the commission and disposed of in
14	accordance with the following provisions:

17	(b) Out of the funds remaining in the Bond Security and Redemption Fund
18	after a sufficient amount is allocated from that fund to pay all obligations secured by
19	the full faith and credit of the state which become due and payable within any fiscal
20	year, the treasurer, prior to placing the remaining funds in the state general fund,
21	shall pay an amount equal to the total amount of funds paid into the state treasury by
22	the commission under the provisions of this Chapter into a special fund which is
23	hereby created in the state treasury and designated as the "Fertilizer Fund" "Feed and
24	Fertilizer Fund".

26	(2) Subject to appropriation, the monies in the fund shall be used for the
27	following purposes:

1	(a) To provide for the expenses of the programs established by Subparts I
2	and II of this Chapter and the expenses of the office of agricultural and
3	environmental sciences, as determined by the commissioner.
4	(b) To renovate, maintain, and equip a building on the Baton Rouge campus
5	of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College to
6	provide administrative offices and analytical laboratories to be used in connection
7	with the programs established by this Subpart Chapter.
8	* * *
9	(3) The Department of Agriculture and Forestry, or the Louisiana
10	Agricultural Finance Authority on behalf of the Department of Agriculture and
11	Forestry, may fund the anticipated funds appropriated from the Fertilizer Fund Feed
12	and Fertilizer Fund into revenue bonds for the purpose of renovating a building on
13	the Baton Rouge campus of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and
14	Mechanical College to provide administrative offices and analytical laboratories to
15	be used in connection with the programs established by this Subpart Chapter and for
16	the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, and equipping buildings and
17	related facilities for use by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry in connection
18	with promoting and assisting agriculture and forestry in this state. The Department
19	of Agriculture and Forestry may pledge those funds to secure the repayment of
20	revenue bonds or to secure a lease or purchase agreement entered into in connection
21	with the issuance of revenue bonds for those purposes.

23	§1430.13. Disposition of fees and penalties
24	A. All fees and penalties provided for in this Subpart Chapter shall be paid
25	to the commission and disposed of as provided in this Section.

27	D. Out of the funds remaining in the Bond Security and Redemption Fund
28	after a sufficient amount is allocated from that fund to pay all obligations secured by
29	the full faith and credit of the state which become due and payable within any fiscal

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1	year, the treasurer, prior to placing the remaining funds in the state general fund,
2	shall pay an amount equal to the total amount of the funds paid into the state treasury
3	under the provisions of this Subpart Chapter into the Fertilizer Fund created by this
4	Chapter Feed and Fertilizer Fund. The funds are to be used for the expenses of the
5	programs established for the purposes of this Subpart Chapter and for the other
6	purposes for which funds in the Fertilizer Fund <u>Feed and Fertilizer Fund</u> may be used
7	as determined by the commissioner.

14	(3) Out of the funds remaining in the Bond Security and Redemption Fund
15	after a sufficient amount is allocated from the fund to pay all obligations secured by

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1	(2) Out of the funds remaining in the Bond Security and Redemption Fund
2	after a sufficient amount is allocated from that fund to pay all obligations secured by
3	the full faith and credit of the state which become due and payable within any fiscal

5	shall pay an amount equal to the total amount of funds paid into the state treasury
6	under the provisions of this Chapter into a special fund which is hereby created in

Abstract: Provides for the merger of certain funds within the La. Dept of Agriculture and Forestry.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Feed Fund and provides for commercial feed registration fees, labeling fees, inspection fees, deficiency assessments, penalties, and fines. Provides for the disposition of all collected fees, payment of obligations, and allowable expenses of feed fund monies.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Fertilizer Fund and provides for registration fees for the sale of fertilizer and agricultural liming materials, inspection fees, tonnage fees, deficiency assessments, penalties, and fines. Provides for the disposition of all collected fees, payment of obligations, and allowable expenses of fertilizer fund monies.

<u>Proposed law</u> merges the Feed Fund and the Fertilizer Fund and creates the Feed and Fertilizer Fund. Expands the allowable expenses of the fund to include the office of agricultural and environmental sciences as determined by the commissioner. Otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Crop Pests and Diseases Fund and provides for nursery stock inspection fees. Provides for the disposition of all collected fees, payment of obligations, and allowable expenses of the crop pests and diseases fund monies.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Apiary Fund and provides for registration fees for colonies or apiaries, inspection fees, assessments on bees, and penalties. Provides for the disposition of all collected fees, payment of obligations, and allowable expenses of apiary fund monies.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Horticulture Commission Fund and provides for examination and license fees for certain professional licenses, permit fees for nursery stock dealers and cut flower dealers, renewal fees, and penalties. Provides for the disposition of all collected fees, payment of obligations, and allowable expenses of horticulture fund monies.

<u>Proposed law</u> merges the Crop Pests and Diseases Fund, the Apiary Fund, and the Horticulture Commission Fund and creates the Horticulture and Quarantine Fund. Expands the allowable expenses of the fund to include the office of agricultural and environmental sciences as determined by the commissioner.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Pesticide Fund and provides for fees collected pursuant to the Louisiana Pesticide Law. Provides for the disposition of fees and the allowable expenses of Pesticide Fund monies.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the allowable expenses of the fund to include the office of agricultural and environmental sciences as determined by the commissioner.
