Proposed law expands allowable expenses of the existing Pesticide Fund to include the Office of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences as determined by the commissioner.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed law merges the Feed Fund and Fertilizer Fund and creates the Feed and Fertilizer Fund. The consolidated Feed and Fertilizer Fund will retain all uses currently allowed by law and expands the allowable uses to include the expenses of the office of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, as determined by the commissioner. <u>The language allowing usage of the fund for operations does not put a cap or maximum percentage that can be utilized.</u>

The proposed law merges the Crop Pests and Diseases Fund, the Apiary Fund, and the Horticulture Commission Fund and creates the Horticulture and Quarantine Fund. The consolidated Horticulture and Quarantine Fund will retain all uses currently allowed by law and expands the allowable uses of the fund to include the Office of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences as determined by the commissioner. The language allowing usage of the fund for operations does not put a cap or maximum percentage that can be utilized.

The department reports consolidation of these funds will result in operational efficiencies in the area of financial management and with field staff that currently charge work hours to numerous funding sources.

The proposed law expands the allowable uses of the existing Pesticide Fund to include the Office of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences as determined by the commissioner. <u>The language allowing usage of the fund for operations does not put a cap or maximum percentage that can be utilized.</u>

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. The revenue sources of the six respective funds are not restructured. The proposed law consolidates five statutory dedications into two.

For informational purposes, only two of the referenced statutory dedications had fund balances at the end of FY 10 according to the state treasurer: the Crop Pests and Diseases Fund at \$65,095 and the Horticulture Commission Fund at \$29,790.
