Proposed bill requires every health insurance issuer to provide claims data not less than 90 days prior to the renewal of a policy. The specific data to include, as requested within the bill, includes: 1.) net claims by month during the policy period, 2.) monthly enrollment by employee only, employee and spouse, employee and family during the policy period, 3.) the amount of any claims reserve established by the insurance provider against future claims, 4.) claims over \$10,000 including claimant identifier, the date of occurrence, the amount of claims paid and those unpaid or oustanding, and claimant health condition or diagnosis, 5.) a complete listing of all potential catastrophic diagnosis and prognosis involving persons covered by the policy.
