EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

This bill may increase local fund expenditures by \$6,480 annually for Sewerage District No. 1 of Rapides Parish.

The proposed bill provides for an increase in per diem paid to each board member from \$90 to \$150 for each board meeting attended. This measure provides for a maximum of 12 emergency and 24 regular meeting per year for a maximum of 36 meetings.

Currently the district consists of 3 members who each receive \$90 for attending a maximum of 36 meetings. If the board meets the statutorily maximum allowable number of times, the current per diem would be \$9,720 annually. If the board meets the maximum number of times with the increased per diem provided in this measure (\$150), expenditures would total \$16,200 annually. Therefore the proposed legislation may increase local fund expenditures by \$6,480 annually (\$16,200 -\$9,720).

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on local governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
