16	PART III-A. POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION DELIVERY SYSTEM FOR
17	THE NEW ORLEANS REGION
18	<u>§3241. Legislative intent; goals</u>
19	A. It is the intent of the legislature that a comprehensive, integrated regional
20	delivery system be provided for the delivery of public postsecondary education
21	services in the New Orleans region which system will:
22	(1) Provide a world class educational environment that will meet the
23	academic needs and interests of every student, while providing each student with the
24	support, assistance, and guidance necessary to attain his or her educational goals and
25	aspirations.
26	(2) Ensure that students who are academically unprepared are provided the
27	educational resources they need to have a reasonable chance for success in their
28	academic pursuits.
29	(3) Raise the educational attainment of the population, improve the quality
30	of life, and contribute to the economic well being of the New Orleans region.
31	(4) Make optimal use of facilities, faculties, and other academic and fiscal
32	resources associated with the public postsecondary institutions in the region.
33	B. The legislature finds that these goals will best be accomplished through
34	the following actions:
35	(1) The Board of Regents shall adopt by not later than February 1, 2012, a
36	written plan of action including timelines, deadlines, requirements, and procedures
37	for achieving the goals specified in Subsection A of this Section as such goals relate
38	to the powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of the board provided by Article
39	VIII, Section 5, of the Constitution of Louisiana and other applicable law. The board
40	shall submit copies of the adopted action plan to the House Committee on Education
41	and the Senate Committee on Education.

1	(2) The Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and
2	Mechanical College, the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana
3	System, and the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges each
4	shall adopt by not later than February 1, 2012, a written plan of action including
5	timelines, deadlines, requirements, and procedures for achieving the goals specified
6	in Subsection A of this Section as they relate to the powers, duties, functions, and
7	responsibilities of the boards provided by Article VIII, Section 5(E), of the
8	Constitution of Louisiana and other applicable law. Each board also shall submit
9	copies of its adopted action plan to the House Committee on Education and the
10	Senate Committee on Education."
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
