Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1923(introductory paragraph) and to enact R.S. 22:1923(1)(j), relative to fraudulent insurance acts; to define certain activity toward a self-insured governmental entity that maintains a self-insured loss fund or risk pool as such an act; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:1923(introductory paragraph) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 22:1923(1)(j) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1923. Definitions

As used in this Part, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated herein: in this Section:

(1) "Fraudulent insurance act" shall include but not be limited to acts or omissions committed by any person who, knowingly and with intent to defraud:

(j) Presents, causes to be presented, or prepares with the knowledge or belief that it will be presented to a self-insured governmental entity any oral or written statement which he knows to contain materially false information as part of, in support of, denial of, or concerning any fact material to or conceals any information concerning any fact material to any claim for payment under such self-insured governmental entity's loss fund or risk pool. For the purposes of this Subparagraph, "self-insured governmental entity" shall mean any agency of the state, political
