Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides licensing exception to certain operators of a mobile command post vehicle. (gov sig)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 32:402(C)(4), relative to motor vehicles; to provide licensing exception to certain operators of a mobile command post vehicle; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:402(C)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§402. All drivers must secure license; exception; emergency vehicle exceptions; military personnel exceptions; emergency command post vehicle exception; violations

* * *

C.(1) * * *

(4) Notwithstanding any provision of this Section or any other law to the contrary, the only driver's license required of an operator of an emergency command post vehicle which would otherwise meet the definition of a commercial motor vehicle, and who is employed by the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness or a parish office of emergency preparedness, shall be a Class "E" driver's license when operating
