

(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

LAW ENFORCEMENT. Provides for the training of all chiefs of police.

DIGEST

Present law requires the Law Enforcement Executive Management Institute to establish a municipal police chief development course and continuing education program.

Present law requires each municipal chief of police to successfully complete the New Chief Management Course and continuing education.

Proposed law retains present law and additionally requires nonmunicipal chiefs of police to complete the management course and continuing education. Provides that the training of the nonmunicipal chiefs of police shall apply to chiefs elected or appointed on or after Jan. 1, 2012. Defines "nonmunicipal chief of police".

Proposed law provides for the exemption of the superintendent of the Louisiana State Police, sheriffs and constables from completing the management course and continuing education.

(Amends R.S. 33:2341 and 2344(A) and (B)(1) and (2); adds R.S. 33:2344(C); 2345(G) and (H))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to the engrossed bill.

1. Exempts the superintendent of the Louisiana State Police, sheriffs and constables from completing the management course and continuing education.
