EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Increases state supplemental pay for each eligible law enforcement individual (deputy sheriffs, police officers, firemen) by \$500 monthly and creates hazardous pay for state police officers in an amount of \$500 monthly. This legislation will result in an increase in state expenditures of \$132 million annually. The increased funding will provide for the implementation of additional compensation to state police officers and doubles the amount currently received by eligible deputy sheriffs, police officers and firemen.

The anticipated increases along with the number of eligible participants are as follows: \$53,634,000 for 8,939 deputy sheriffs; \$39,216,000 for 6,536 police officers; \$32,856,000 for 5,476 firefighters, and \$6,288,000 for 1,048 state police officers.
