HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 56

BY REPRESENTATIVE SCHRODER

APPROPRIATIONS: Formulates a method for identifying expenditures as recurring or one-time

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To direct the staff of the House, Senate, and the Legislative Fiscal Office to meet to
3 formulate a method for identifying expenditures as recurring or one-time.

4 WHEREAS, the state budget continues to rely on one-time money to fund recurring
5 expenses; and

6 WHEREAS, the passage of House Rule 7.19 places further conditions on the use of
7 one-time money; and

8 WHEREAS, restricting use of one-time money to one-time expenses is critical to the
9 formation of sound fiscal policy; and

10 WHEREAS, identifying one-time expenses in the state budget will enable the
11 legislature to make informed decisions about the use of one-time money.

12 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the staff of the House, Senate, and the
13 Legislative Fiscal Office are hereby directed to meet to formulate a method for identifying
14 expenditures as recurring or one-time.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the staff shall provide the legislature with a
16 report which includes the methodology to be used to identify expenses as recurring or one-
17 time not later than October 1, 2011.
