**Abstract:** Authorizes domestic abuse advocates to provide clerical assistance to petitioners in filing protective orders.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the clerk of court shall make forms available and provide assistance to petitioners in filing a protective order.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally authorizes domestic abuse advocates to provide clerical assistance to petitioners in filing a protective order.

Proposed law defines "domestic abuse advocate".
