

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 72 by Representative Gisclair

LAW ENFORCEMENT: Provides for the training of all chiefs of police

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Added an exception for the superintendent of the Louisiana State Police, sheriffs, and constables.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law requires the Law Enforcement Executive Management Institute to establish a municipal police chief development course and continuing education program.

Present law requires each municipal chief of police to successfully complete the New Chief Management Course and continuing education.

Proposed law retains present law and additionally requires nonmunicipal chiefs of police to complete the management course and continuing education. Provides that the training of the nonmunicipal chiefs of police shall apply to chiefs elected or appointed on or after Jan. 1, 2012. Defines "nonmunicipal chief of police".

Proposed law shall not apply to the superintendent of the Louisiana State Police, sheriffs, and constables.
