2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:1448(H)(1) and to enact R.S. 33:1448(H)(3), relative to
3	payment of group insurance premiums for persons retired from the Assumption
4	Parish Sheriff's Office; to require service with the Assumption Parish Sheriff's Office
5	for a specified number of years after a specified date; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 33:1448(H)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
9	33:1448(H)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§1448. Group insurance; kinds; amounts; subrogation
11	* * *
12	H.(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection D of this Section, one
13	hundred percent of the premium costs of group hospital, surgical, medical expense,
14	and dental insurance, and the first ten thousand dollars of life insurance contracted
15	for under the provisions of this Section shall be paid by the sheriff of Assumption
16	Parish from the sheriff's general fund for all sheriffs and deputy sheriffs who retire
17	on or after July 1, 2001, and before July 1, 2011, from the Assumption Parish
18	sheriff's office Sheriff's Office with at least twenty years of service and who are at
19	least fifty-five years of age.

21	(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection D of this Section, one
22	hundred percent of the premium costs of group hospital, surgical, medical expense,
23	and dental insurance, and the first ten thousand dollars of life insurance contracted
