

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 505 by Representative Champagne

MTR VEHICLE/OFFICE: Requires interlock companies to report electronically

Synopsis of Senate Amendments	
1.	Required ignition interlock devices to be monitored by the manufacturer for proper use at least bi-monthly rather than monthly.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law requires ignition interlock devices to be monitored by the manufacturer for proper use at least semiannually.

Proposed law requires ignition interlock devices to be monitored by the manufacturer for proper use at least bimonthly.

Present law requires ignition interlock devices to be monitored by the manufacturer and that a report of such monitoring be submitted to the court and DPS&C.

Proposed law retains present law and requires that the report submitted to DPS&C be submitted in an electronic format specified by DPS&C.
