HOUSE BILL NO. 164

BY REPRESENTATIVE HILL AND SENATOR SMITH

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

AN ACT

To designate that section of Louisiana Highway 113, between its intersection with Louisiana Highway 10, in Vernon Parish, to the Occupy II Baptist Church as the "Staff Sergeant Robert 'Pete' Sweat Memorial Highway"; to designate that section of Louisiana Highway 18 between its intersection with US Highway 90 east to its intersection with Louisiana Highway 541, in Jefferson Parish, as "Seven Oaks Boulevard"; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. The section of Louisiana Highway 113, between its intersection with Louisiana Highway 10, in Vernon Parish, to the Occupy II Baptist Church (3.9 miles) shall be hereinafter known and designated as the "Staff Sergeant Robert 'Pete' Sweat Memorial Highway".

Section 2. The section of Louisiana Highway 18 between its intersection with US Highway 90 east to its intersection with Louisiana Highway 541 in Jefferson Parish shall be hereinafter known and designated as "Seven Oaks Boulevard".

Section 3. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are hereby directed to erect appropriate signage reflecting this designation.
