2	To enact R.S. 33:1236(66), relative to the Ouachita Parish Police Jury; to authorize the
3	prohibition of certain sales; and to provide for related matters.
4	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 33:1236(66) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1236. Powers of parish governing authorities
8	The police juries and other parish governing authorities shall have the
9	following powers:
10	* * *
11	(66) The governing authority of Ouachita Parish shall have the authority
12	to enact ordinances prohibiting the sales of certain animals along roadsides, in
13	parking lots, and in other outdoor areas in the unincorporated areas of
14	Ouachita Parish.
15	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
16	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
17	by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
18	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
19	effective on the day following such approval.
