| 11 | necessary, advise indigent applicants of the availability of filing in forma pauperis, |
| 12 | provide the necessary forms, as supplied by the judicial administrator's office, |
| 13 | Louisiana Supreme Court, and provide the services of a notary, where available, for |
| 14 | completion of the affidavit required in R.S. 46:2134(D). |
| 15 | B. Domestic abuse advocates may provide clerical assistance to petitioners |
| 16 | in making an application for a protective order in accordance with this Part. |
| 17 | C. For purposes of this Section, "domestic abuse advocate" means an |
| 18 | employee or representative of a community based shelter providing services to |
| 19 | victims of family violence or domestic abuse. |
