## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The legislation does not require the agency to provide any additional services.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Senate

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. The agency has not received any requests for the U.S. Armed Forces plate, therefore none of these plates have been sold and the agency has never received any revenue from the \$3.50 handling fee provided for in the existing statues. Act 32 of the 2010 Regular Session created the "U. S. Armed Forces" plate. Act 32 also provided that the fee for the military plate be the same as the fee for a regular license plate, plus a handling fee of \$3.50. The act limited applicants for such plate to members of the five active-duty services and their respective guard and reserve units of the armed forces of the United States. The plate is restricted to passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, and vans.

In addition, per statute the Office of Motor Vehicles offers approximately 24 various military plates that do not require the payment of the \$3.50 handling fee. This bill eliminates the handling fee for the U.S. Armed Forces plate.
