AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:3217.1(A) and to enact R.S. 17:3230, relative to
3	postsecondary education; to provide for the creation of the Northshore Technical
4	Community College; to provide with respect to the management, supervision, and
5	operation of the institution; to provide with respect to program offerings; to provide
6	for the awarding of certificates, diplomas, and degrees; to provide for the duties and
7	responsibilities of the Board of Regents and the Board of Supervisors of Community
8	and Technical Colleges; to provide relative to accreditation; to provide reporting
9	requirements; and to provide for related matters.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 17:3217.1(A) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:3230 is
12	hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	§3217.1. Louisiana Community and Technical Colleges system
14	A. The Louisiana Community and Technical College System is composed of
15	the institutions under the supervision and management of the Board of Supervisors
16	of Community and Technical Colleges as follows:
17	(1) Baton Rouge Community College.
18	(2) Bossier Parish Community College in Bossier Parish.
19	(3) Delgado Community College.
20	(4) Elaine P. Nunez Community College.
21	(5) L.E. Fletcher Technical Community College.
22	(6) Louisiana Delta Community College.
23	(7) Northshore Technical Community College.

10	§3230. Northshore Technical Community College; creation, management, and
11	<u>operation</u>
12	A. (1) Pursuant to the authority granted the legislature by Article VIII,
13	Section 5(D)(3) of the Constitution of Louisiana to create a new institution by
14	law enacted by two-thirds of the elected members of each house, the Northshore
15	Technical Community College is hereby created and established as a multi-
16	campus, public institution of postsecondary education. The institution and its
17	programs shall be under the supervision and management of the Board of
18	Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, subject to the appropriate
19	approval of and oversight by the Board of Regents.
20	(2) The institution shall provide a comprehensive educational program
21	to meet the needs of the students and communities within its primary service
22	delivery area. Such program may include career and technical education and
23	training, workforce development training, adult basic education, continuing
24	education, general education, associate degree programs, college transfer degree
25	programs, and other educational programs and opportunities.
26	B. The Northshore Technical Community College may grant certificates,
27	diplomas, associate degrees, and associate transfer degrees as authorized by the
28	Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges and the
29	appropriate regional accrediting body as recognized by the United States
30	Department of Education.

C. The Northshore Technical Community College shall provide educational programs and services through the Florida Parishes Campus, the Hammond Area Campus, and the Sullivan Campus of the Louisiana Technical College, and any other postsecondary campus or institution which may become a part of the Northshore Technical Community College or its primary service delivery area.

D. The Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges and the Board of Regents shall work closely with the Northshore Technical Community College and the appropriate accrediting body to ensure that the institution and all program offerings are fully accredited.

E. The Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges shall submit a written report to the Senate Committee on Education and the House Committee on Education relative to the status of the Northshore Technical Community College, not later than January 1, 2012.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
