2	To amend and reenact R.S. 36:642(C)(1), 643, 645(A)(5), 646, 648, and 649, to enact R.S.
3	36:648.1, to repeal R.S. 17:23 and Chapter 34 of Title 17 of the Louisiana Revised
4	Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 17:3781 through 3784, and to repeal R.S.
5	36:647, relative to the Department of Education; to provide relative to the offices
6	within the department and their functions; to provide relative to the titles of the
7	officers of the department; to provide relative to the appointment and duties of the
8	deputy superintendent of education; to remove provisions relative to the purposes
9	and functions of certain offices; to remove duplicative and outdated provisions; to
10	delete provisions relative to the establishment, governance, programs, and services
11	of the regional education service centers; and to provide for related matters.
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
13	Section 1. R.S. 36:642(C)(1), 643, 645(A)(5), 646, 648, and 649 are hereby amended
14	and reenacted and R.S. 36:648.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
15	§642. Department of Education; creation; domicile; composition; purposes and
16	function
17	* * *
18	C.(1) The Department of Education shall be composed of the executive office
19	of the superintendent, the office of management and finance, the office of student
20	and school performance, the office of quality educators, the office of school and
21	community support, the technical college system literacy, the office of science,
22	technology, engineering, and mathematics, the office of college and career
23	readiness, the office of departmental support, the office of innovation, special
24	school district number one, and such other offices as shall be created by law.

26	§643. Officers of the department; compensation for one office only
27	A. The officers of the department shall be the superintendent of education,

1	the deputy superintendent of education, the deputy superintendent for
2	management and finance, the deputy superintendent, if a deputy superintendent is
3	appointed, and an assistant deputy superintendent for each office of the department.
4	With the exception of the superintendent of education, each of them shall be selected
5	as provided in this Title. They shall perform functions as provided in this Title. $\frac{1}{10}$
6	a The deputy superintendent is appointed, he shall be the first assistant to the
7	superintendent appointed pursuant to Article IV, Section 13 of the constitution. $\frac{1}{10}$
8	a deputy superintendent is not appointed, the superintendent shall appoint his first
9	assistant to the office of deputy superintendent for management and finance or to one
10	of the offices of assistant superintendent.
11	B. No person serving as a superintendent, deputy superintendent, deputy
12	superintendent for management and finance, or assistant deputy superintendent shall
13	receive any additional salary from the state other than that salary which he receives
14	by virtue of serving in any one of such offices.
15	C. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, subject to approval
16	of the superintendent, any person serving as deputy superintendent for management
17	and finance, deputy superintendent or assistant deputy superintendent may receive
18	additional compensation for part-time services rendered as an instructor in post-
19	secondary educational institutions, or as a member of the National Guard.

21	§645. Powers and duties of superintendent of education
22	A. In addition to the functions, powers, and duties otherwise vested in the
23	superintendent by law, he shall:

25	(5) Except for agencies transferred as provided in R.S. 36:801.1, and except
26	for provisions of the constitution to the contrary, act as the sole agent of the state or,
27	in necessary cases, designate one of the offices within the department or its assistant
28	deputy superintendent, to cooperate with the federal government and with other state
29	and local agencies in matters of mutual concern and in the administration of federal
30	funds granted to the state or directly to the department or an office thereof to aid in

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1	the furtherance of any function of the department and its offices. For this purpose he
2	may take such actions, in accordance with applicable state law, necessary to meet
3	such federal standards as are established for the administration and use of such

7	§646. Deputy superintendent
8	There may shall be a deputy superintendent of the department, who shall be
9	appointed by the superintendent with consent of the Senate and who shall serve at
10	the pleasure of the superintendent at a salary fixed by the superintendent which
11	salary shall not exceed the amount approved for such position by the legislature
12	while in session. If appointed, the The deputy superintendent shall be the first
13	assistant of the superintendent of education. The duties and functions of the deputy
14	superintendent shall be determined and assigned by the superintendent. He shall
15	serve as acting superintendent in the absence of the superintendent as provided by
16	law.

18	§648. Assistant <u>deputy</u> superintendents
19	A. Each office within the Department of Education, except the office of
20	management and finance, shall be under the immediate supervision and direction of
21	an assistant deputy superintendent, who shall be appointed by the superintendent
22	with consent of the Senate. Each shall serve at the pleasure of the superintendent and
23	shall be paid a salary which shall be fixed by the superintendent which salaryand
24	shall not exceed the amount approved for such position by the legislature while in
25	session.
26	B. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Title, the duties and
27	functions of each office and its assistant deputy superintendent shall be determined
28	by the superintendent, and all of such duties and functions shall be exercised under
29	the direct supervision and control of the superintendent.
30	D. C. Each assistant deputy superintendent shall exercise all powers and

3	§648.1. Special school district number one; administration
4	A. Special school district number one shall be under the administration
5	and supervision of a state director who shall be appointed by the state
6	superintendent of education, subject to confirmation by the Senate.
7	B. The salary of the state director of special school district number one
8	shall be fixed by the state superintendent and shall not exceed the amount
9	approved for such position by the legislature while in session.
10	C. The state director of special school district number one shall exercise
11	his duties and functions under the direct supervision and control of the state
12	superintendent of education.
13	§649. Offices; purposes and functions relating to elementary and secondary
14	education
15	A. The purposes for which the offices in the Department of Education are
16	created shall be as set forth in this Section.
17	B. The office of student and school performance shall perform the functions
18	of the state relating to student and school standards, assessment, accountability, and
19	assistance, including exceptional children literacy shall perform the functions of
20	the state relating to reading and writing, all in accordance with applicable law.
21	C. The office of quality educators shall perform the functions of the state
22	relating to teachers and administrators, including assessment and evaluation,
23	certification, and staff development science, technology, engineering, and
24	mathematics shall perform the functions of the state relating to science,
25	technology, engineering, and numeracy, all in accordance with applicable law.
26	D. The office of school and community support shall perform the functions
27	of the state relating to student, school, and community health and nutrition programs,
28	and transportation programs college and career readiness shall perform the
29	functions of the state relating to dropout prevention and preparing students for
30	college or career and technical education, all in accordance with applicable law.
