COURTS/COURT COSTS: Provides for the disbursement of court costs collected in criminal cases

Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:

- 1. Added provision requiring the payment of off duty law enforcement witness fees to be paid by the party issuing the subpoena in the city of New Orleans.
- 2. Deleted provision requiring judges in the city of New Orleans to adopt a schedule of court costs regarding the payment of witness fees.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the person or agency responsible for receiving court fines, fees, costs, assessments, and forfeitures to distribute them monthly with an itemized detail of the source of the funds.
