1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2091(B) and (C), relative to the Registrars of Voters
3	Employees' Retirement System; to provide for membership of and election to the
4	board of trustees; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 11:2091(B) and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§2091. Board of trustees; membership; vacancies; compensation
10	* * *
11	B. The board shall consist of six eight trustees as follows:
12	(1) The secretary of the Registrars of Voters Association of Louisiana
13	chairman of the House Committee on Retirement, ex-officio, and ex officio, or
14	<u>his designee</u> .
15	(2) The president of the Registrars of Voters Association of Louisiana
16	chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, ex-officio, and ex officio, or
17	<u>his designee</u> .
18	(3) Four <u>Six</u> active and contributing members of the system who shall have
19	at least ten years of creditable service in the Registrars of Voters Employees'
20	Retirement System who shall be elected by the members of the Registrars of Voters
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1	Association Employees' Retirement System according to such the rules and
2	regulations adopted by as the board of trustees shall adopt to govern such elections.
3	The term of office of the four six elected board members shall be for a period of four
4	years ; provided, that one elected member whose term of office begins January
5	1, 2012, shall serve an initial term of two years, with subsequent terms of four
6	years. No elected trustee may serve for more than two consecutive four-year
7	terms, exclusive of any term being served on December 31, 2011. If an elected
8	trustee elects to participate in the Deferred Retirement Option Plan after his term has
9	commenced, he may continue to serve for the remainder of the term for which he
10	was elected; however, if he otherwise separates from service, his term shall expire.
11	(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (3) of this Subsection,
12	<u>the term of office for any person elected and serving on the board of trustees on</u>
13	December 31, 2011, shall be extended to December thirty-first of the year in
14	which the term expires.
15	C. If a vacancy occurs in the office of an elected trustee, the board of trustees
16	of the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System shall appoint a member
17	to the unexpired term of office, provided that if the unexpired term is for a period of
18	more than two years, the appointment shall be for the period intervening until the
19	next annual meeting of the Registrars of Voters Association regularly scheduled
20	election, at which time a member shall be elected to fill the unexpired portion of the
21	term in accordance with the rules governing the election of board members.

23	Section 2. The board of trustees of the retirement system shall promulgate rules in
24	accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act or take any other action the board deems
25	necessary and prudent for the orderly transition and implementation of the provisions of this
26	Act.
27	Section 3. The provisions of Sections 2, 3, and 4 of this Act shall become effective
28	on July 1, 2011; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this
29	Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011, or on the day following such approval by the
30	legislature, whichever is later.

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- 1 Section 4. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on January
- 2 1, 2012.
