2	To amend and reenact R.S. 3:3406(A)(2), 3419(D), the introductory paragraph of 3421, and
3	3423(D)(1), relative to the Agricultural Commodity Dealer and Warehouse Law; to
4	provide relative to powers of the commissioner; to provide relative to records; to
5	transfer the authority of determining the expenses of the Agricultural Commodity
6	Dealers and Warehouse Fund from the commission to the commissioner; and to
7	provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 3:3406(A)(2), 3419(D), the introductory paragraph of 3421, and
10	3423(D)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
11	\$3406. Powers and duties of the commissioner
12	A. The commissioner shall administer and enforce this Chapter in accordance
13	with the rules and regulations promulgated by the commission. In the administration
14	and enforcement of this Chapter, the commissioner and his duly constituted
15	representatives are specifically authorized to do the following:

17	(2) Examine, copy, and audit the accounts, books, and records, including
18	stock records, position records, balance sheets, scale tickets, and warehouse receipts
19	of any warehouse, cotton merchant or cotton agent, or grain dealer required to be
20	licensed under this Chapter, including all warehouses or grain dealers, or both,
21	licensed under the United States Warehouse Act, as amended, and any applicant for
22	licensure under this Chapter, or as otherwise permitted under this Chapter.

3	D. Each warehouse, cotton merchant, and grain dealer shall permit any
4	officer or authorized representative of the commission to enter all locations listed on
5	the application of such warehouse, cotton merchant, or grain dealer and inspect,
6	copy, examine, or audit all contents, facilities, equipment, records, books, and
7	accounts relating thereto. Such inspection, copying, examination, or audit may be
8	made on any business day, during normal working hours. The warehouse, cotton
9	merchant, or grain dealer shall provide the necessary assistance required for any
10	inspection, copying, examination, or audit made in accordance with this Chapter or
11	the rules and regulations adopted pursuant hereto.

13	§3421. Confidentiality of records
14	Notwithstanding the provisions of Part II of Chapter 1 of Title 44 of the
15	Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, all financial statements, position reports, and
16	any other documents required for licensure and filed by applicants for licensure
17	under this Chapter shall be kept confidential by the commission and its agents and
18	employees and are not subject to disclosure except as follows:

20	§3423. Deposit of the revenues of the commission; Agricultural Commodity
21	Dealers and Warehouse Fund

23	D. Subject to appropriation, the monies in the fund shall be used for the
24	following purposes:
25	(1) To provide for the expenses of the program established by this Chapter,
26	as determined by the commission <u>commissioner</u> .

28	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
29	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
30	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
