

Existing law prohibits a parish court or city court from having jurisdiction in a case in which the state, or a parish, municipal, or other political corporation is a defendant.

New law adds an exception to the prohibition and authorizes the City Court of Slidell to have jurisdiction over a petition for nullity filed in the City Court of Slidell to nullify a judgment of bond forfeiture rendered by the City Court of Slidell.

Effective August 15, 2011.
