Burrell (HB 255) Act No. 234

<u>Existing law</u> provides that the clerk of court shall make forms available and provide assistance to petitioners in filing a protective order.

<u>New law retains existing law</u> and additionally authorizes domestic abuse advocates to provide clerical assistance to petitioners in filing a protective order.

New law defines "domestic abuse advocate".

Effective August 15, 2011.
