

New law requires the secretary for DPS&C to issue special prestige license plates to be known as the "Feeding Hope" license plate.

New law provides that the prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

New law provides for the secretary to design the "Feeding Hope" license plate, with the color and design to be selected by the La. Food Bank Association, Inc.

New law provides that an annual royalty fee of \$25 shall be collected by the department and forwarded to the La. Food Bank Association, Inc., or its successor organization. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used solely for nonprofit efforts. Further provides that the fee for the license plate shall be the standard registration license fee and a handling fee of \$3.50 to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

New law provides that the secretary shall adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in new law.

Effective August 15, 2011.
