

Prior law provided for legislative intent regarding the state's interest to allow residents of Louisiana to purchase or obtain rifles and shotguns or ammunition in states contiguous to Louisiana.

Prior law provided for definitions.

Prior law provides that it shall be lawful for any person residing in Louisiana to purchase or otherwise obtain a rifle or shotgun or ammunition in any state which is contiguous to Louisiana and to receive or transport such rifle or shotgun or ammunition into this state.

Prior law further lawfully permitted any person residing in a contiguous state to purchase shotguns, rifles, or ammunition in Louisiana and to receive or transport such rifles, shotguns, or ammunition in Louisiana.

Prior law provided for applicability of prior law.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective August 15, 2011.
